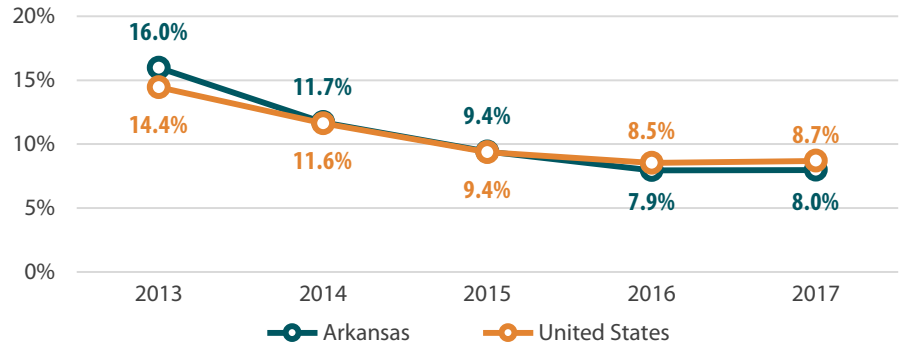

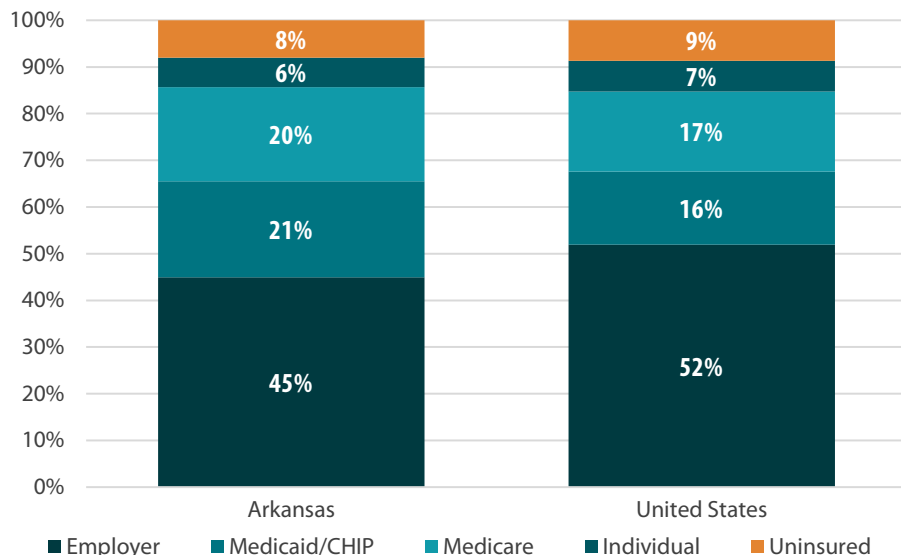

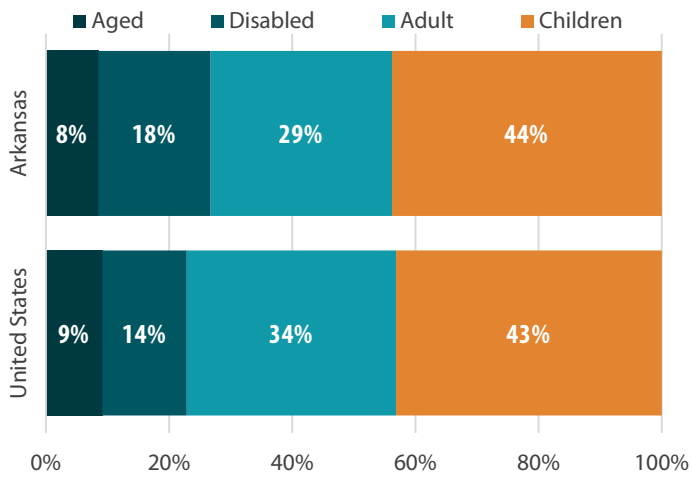

Medicaid Enrollees by Enrollment Group, 2014\*



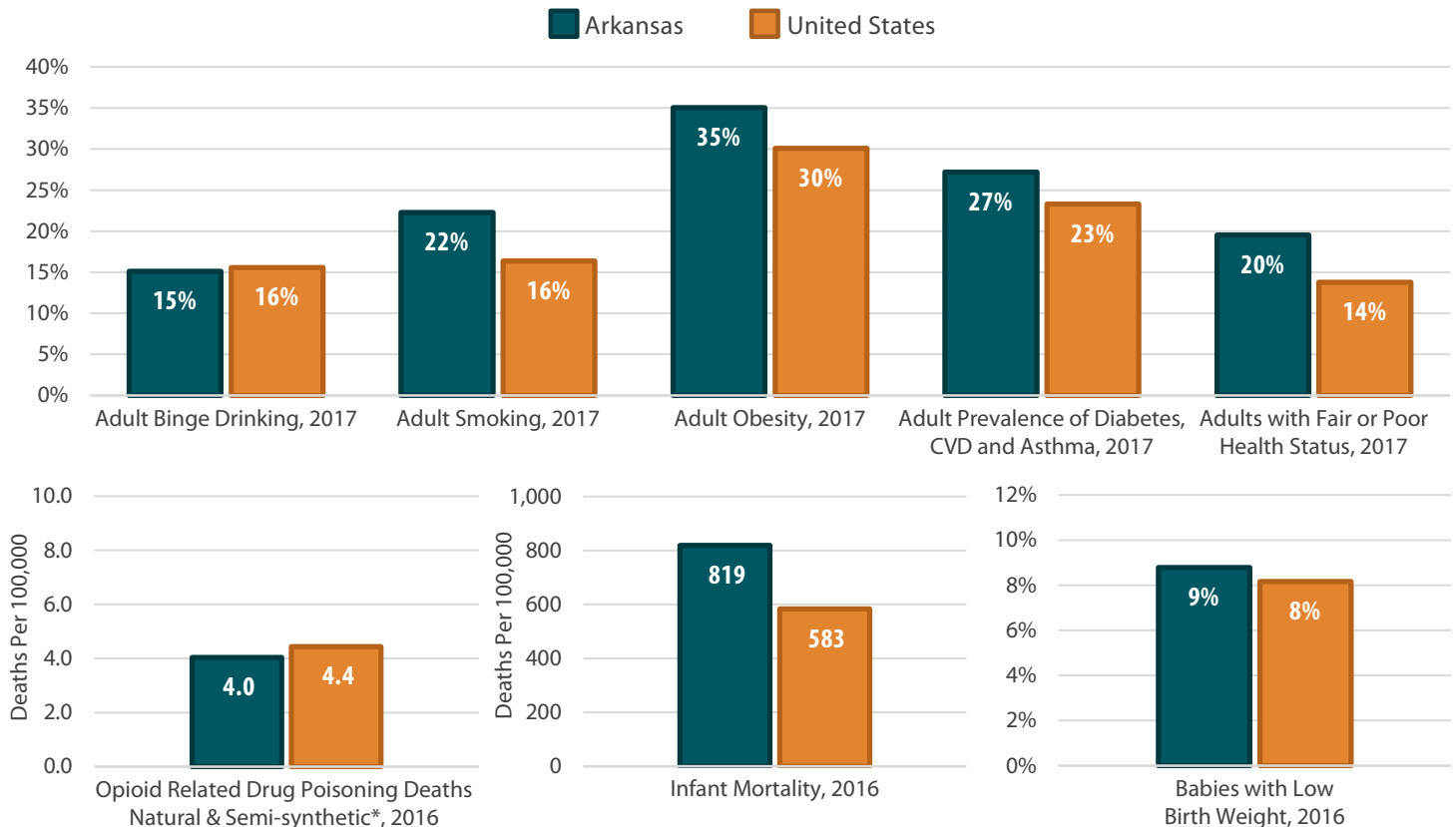
