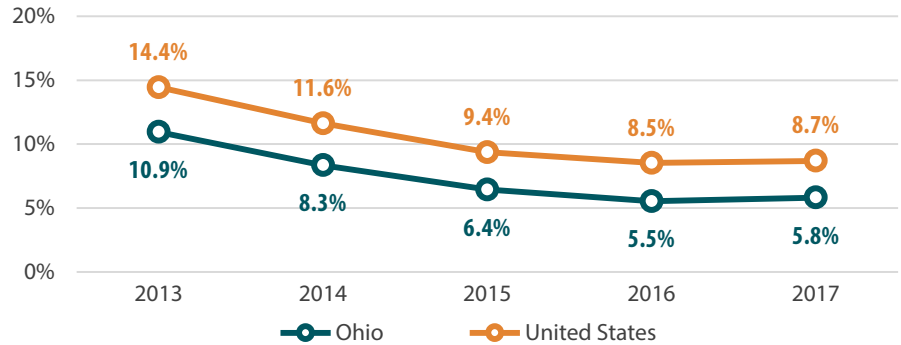

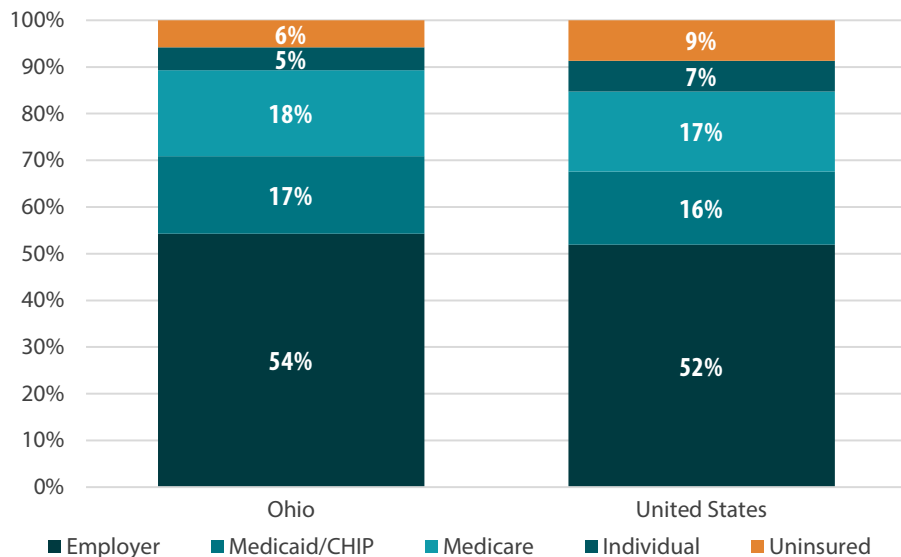

Uninsurance Rate, 2013-2017

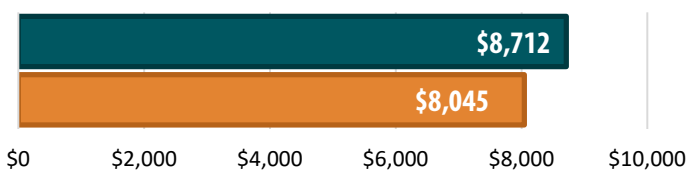


Primary Source of Coverage, 2017

Health Care Expenditures per Capita, 2014

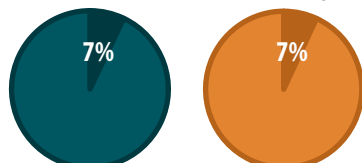


Public Health Funding per Capita, 2016

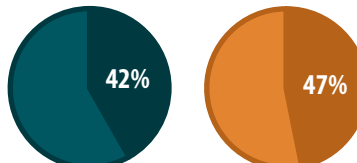

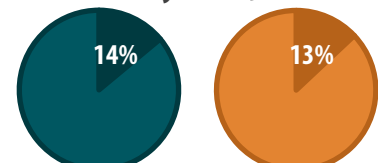
Households Receiving SNAP Benefits or Cash Assistance, 2017



Households with Unaffordable Rents, 2017



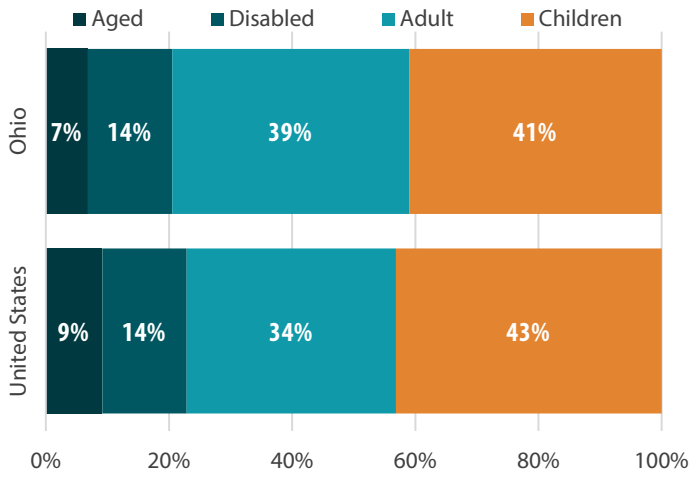
Population Below Poverty Level, 2017

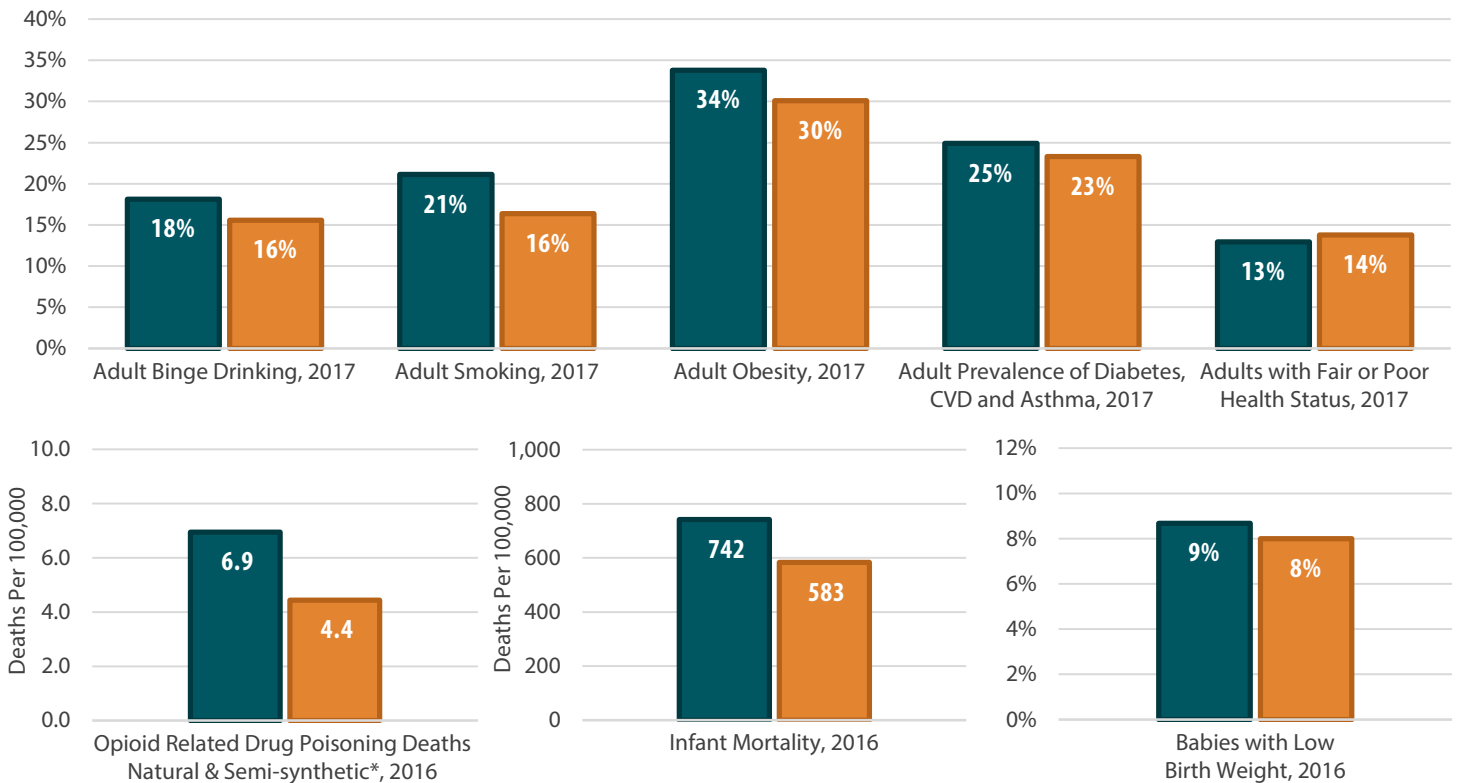
